Administrative Items

- A Pre-Construction Meeting for the Park Building project was held on August 14 at the Park Building.
- The Parks Foreman met with our Gametime representative regarding replacement items for certain playground equipment on August 20.
- Director and Parks Foreman attended NIMS Training on August 21 and received certification.
- Director and Program Director attend the York County Recreation Directors' Meeting on August 26.
- A Construction Meeting was held on August 27 at the Park Building to assess the first few days of the project. Next meeting set for September 10.
- Director met with the MPCG consultant to discuss kick-off meeting with Study Committee and Steering Committee on August 27.
- Director attended Mill Creek Preserve site walk with representatives from the EAC to determine readiness of project in order to hand over to Recreation/Public Works.

Programs

- **SUMMER PLAYGROUND**—The last day for the Summer Playground Program was Friday, August 15. There were a total of 196 children participating in this year's program. The program went very well with a minimum number of incidents.
- **VOLUNTEERS**—The program finished on Friday, August 15. August projects included helping the Playground campers at Dutch Wonderland, scraping and painting benches at Lion's Park, and helping clear trails for York County Parks.
- **SPECIALITY CAMPS**—The last UK Soccer Camp was held August 11-15 and had 32 children in the Recreation program. There were not enough children registered for the Nipper or Goalie Camp. During the week of August 4, there were five children attending the Golf Camp that the department offered at Heritage Hills Golf Resort.
- **BOCCE**—The Summer Bocce League was able to start and the weather has been absolutely wonderful! Originally there were seven teams of four people, but because of the late start for the league, one team had to drop out. The league will end on September 27.
- **Girl's Softball** – Another season has been enjoyed by returning players, as well as new players. There were a total of 113 girls ages 7-16 playing for York Township Recreation. There were losses, wins and a lot of smiles and good friends made throughout the season. The girls received trophies for their participation. Registration for Fall Softball resulted in 2 teams being fielded.
- **VERA KYWA'S DANCE CLASSES**—The Bolero and West Coast Swing dance classes ended on Tuesday, August 26. There were seventeen registered for the Bolero and ten registered for the West Coast Swing Class. The instructor is interested in teaching more evening classes now that she is available.
- **FREE FRIDAY NIGHT FLICKS**—The movies were scheduled to end on Friday, August 29, but rain caused the movie to be postponed until Friday, September 5.
