Frank's Theaters Ticket Sales – Dean made a motion that Debra should check to see if the 3-D is an option and she be authorized to purchase up to 100 tickets. Joseph seconded. All approved.

Outfield Fence on York Township Park Ball Field #2 – The Oldtimers are planning to purchase new temporary fencing they use for their season. The Board discussed the possibility of installing permanent fencing instead of using temporary fencing as a permanent fence might allow for more tournaments to be scheduled at the park. The Board decided against installing a permanent fence and agreed that the new temporary fencing proposed by the Oldtimers is acceptable. The new fencing would have shafts that would be left in the ground similar to base plugs and should not interfere with mowing.

Stump Park Field Usage – The fields will be ready to use in the spring. Debra has had lots of requests to use the fields. (lacrosse and soccer) Debra felt that we should let lacrosse use the fields at Stump as this would return a field back into the soccer rotation at York Township Park. Debra suggested one field for games and two fields for practice. Joseph made a motion that we let lacrosse

use all fields (or what is needed) at Stump Park in the spring with no additional commitment at this time. Dean seconded. All approved.

Stump Park Sign – Joseph spoke to someone from York Stone. They are willing to donate a rock for the sign at Stump Park. Debra and Joseph will check it out.
