Programs

- **Summer Playground-** This month, the playground campers enjoyed fieldtrips to Roll-R-Way, Suburban Bowlerama, South York Movies and a Senator's baseball game.
- **Summer Concerts-** On July 1, Dave Holt performed and for the last concert of the season, the Rob Dickinson Duo brought the house down.
- **Discover Days with Diego** – HOLA!! Let's rescue the Red Eyed Tree Frog from the waterfall!!! This month children ages 3, 4 & 5 years old learned about Dora's cousin, Diego. During the class the children rescued rainforest animals, made jaguar and bear mask and learned to say their colors in Spanish.
- **Summer Specialty Camps-** The second session of the UK Soccer Camp began July 16th – 20th and there were 15 children registered for the UK Rec program. The Goalkeeper and Nipper program did not have enough participants.
- **York Township Girl's Summer Softball League** – This season went very well. The 12U major team was very strong and had a great season finishing with a 9 W-5 L record. The 10U Minor White Thunders finished with an 11 W-3 L record, the Royals finished 6 wins, 6 losses and 2 ties and the Blue Rascals finished 6 wins, 7 losses and 1 tie. The 12U & 14U minor teams seemed to struggle a bit, but everyone had a great time, and made new friends.
- **Volunteens Program**—The Volunteens Program continued in July with community service projects completed with the York Rescue Mission and at York Township Park.
- **Keystone State Games**—The Keystone State Games used York Township Park from July 24-29 for baseball and female lacrosse games. The Public Works Park Maintenance Staff was supplemented with assistance from the York Township Baseball Team.
